

Quick and Easy Baby Quilt

(finishes approx. 43" square)

You will need:

36 - 6" squares of children's fabric

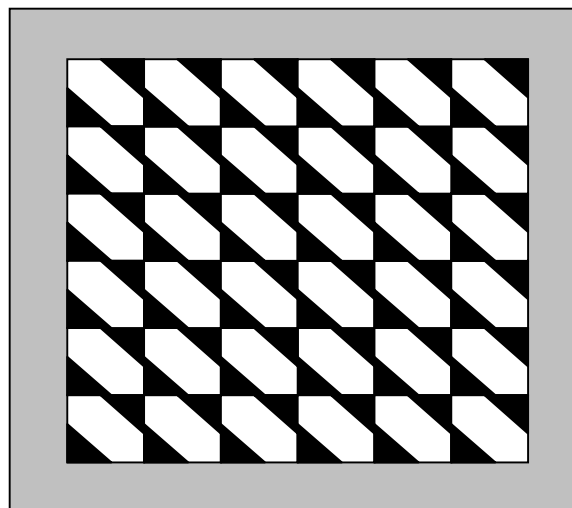
72 - 3 1/4" squares of one color fabric

4 - 5 1/2" x 44" strips for border

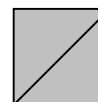
45" x 45" backing fabric

45" x 45" batting

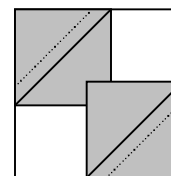
1/3 yard of contrasting fabric for binding



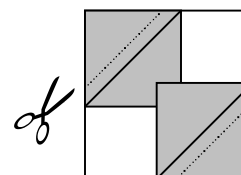
With a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the **wrong** side of the 3 1/4" squares.



With **right** sides together, place a 3 1/4" square on diagonal corners of each 6" square. Sew **on** the diagonal line, and then sew **again** 1/2" outside of that line (toward the outer corner).



Cut between the two lines and return the extra half square triangles to FHQ.



Press seams of the 6" blocks toward outside corners.
Repeat until you have 36 blocks.

Arrange and sew 6 blocks for each of 6 rows.
Press seams in each row in the opposite direction so it's easier to match the seams when connecting the rows together.

Sew the 6 rows together, matching and lining up the seams from row to row.
Press the row seams well, in one direction.

Add 5 1/2" borders around quilt top.

Layer batting between your completed quilt top and the backing fabric.
Quilt or tie the quilt, square up the entire quilt, add binding and sew on FHQ quilt label.

Return completed quilt to FHQ for delivery.
